

**LDR MEETING IN BERLIN, DEUTSCHLAND**  
**MINUTES OF THE LDR MEETING APRIL 20, 2018**

Present: 19 attendees.

1. Johan welcomes everybody.

2. He expressed his joy that again such a number of people attended the meeting. It seems there is a growing number of people interested in being a part of our practice group.

3. He emphasized again that we need more cooperation from the LDR members to organize everything within LDR. Now only a few people are really active. We need more volunteers to cooperate in organizing the events, realizing the newsletter etc.

4. Johan especially thanked Karl Friedrich Du Moulin for his everlasting efforts to get the LDR newsletter published. This time the newsletter was only realized in the last minute. Karl Friedrich emphasizes that LDR members should be more active in producing articles.

This can even be done in their own language. Headquarters will then take care of translation.

5. Due to the usual lack of time, Johan invites everybody to only use one minute to introduce themselves and their firms.

Then he gives the floor to Wolfgang Fuernschuss Who gives a presentation on the aspects of asset protection a Liechtenstein foundation provides, in particular, the lack of jurisdiction for proceedings against a Liechtenstein foundation even in case there is a final non-Liechtenstein judgment against the foundation's (foreign) beneficiary.

After the presentation of Wolfgang, Johan gives the floor to Dr. Karl Friedrich Du Moulin who gives a presentation on The European Order for Payment (EOP) Regulation EC 1896/2006 created a first genuine European civil procedure – the EOP procedure. The presentation gave an overview on the scope of application, procedure, issuing and serving as well as opposition and enforceability.

7. Johan thanks Wolfgang and Karl Friedrich for their excellent presentations and asks them to send the presentation by email to the attendees if possible.

Johan reminds everybody that the next meetings will be during the North American meeting, during the world conference in Argentina and there are plans to organize the standalone meeting again in Miami, Florida in the second or third weekend of November. Perhaps however this meeting has to be organized in February/March 2019 due to the many events that are planned by GGI during these weekends in November. He has asked Linda to look into the possibilities and Johan will discuss this with Henry Willett.
