Relaxation in Tax Residency Rules for Individuals and Consequent Impacts

Due to the pandemic, many individuals were held up in countries for an extended period of time. Irrespective of whether they were in those countries on holiday or on a planned business trip or if one of their homes is in that country, there is a tax residency impact based on the number of days they have spent in that country, albeit unwillingly.

Globally, there was an expectation (rather, hope) that countries would announce relaxations towards the exclusion of a certain number of days while determining the number of days an individual spends in that country. It is time to update fellow PG members on what these relaxations are, if any, provided by the countries in the region.
