The EU budget focuses on bringing growth and jobs, tackling climate change, migration, cross-border crime and other challenges. It helps boost prosperity, for example by better interconnecting Europeans through energy, transport and ICT infrastructure, by supporting less well-off regions to create growth and jobs both there and in the rest of the EU, and by pooling efforts in areas like research.
