



MINUTES WEBEX-MEETING MAY 30, 2013

1. Johan started the meeting around 17:00 hours CET.
2. Some technical problems were experienced, since some people, who wanted to attend the meeting, could not log in and in a later stage there was a lot of interference.
3. Johan welcomed everybody and the first topic he introduced was 'electronic discovery'. This item was also discussed during the European- and the North-American conference.
4. Michael Quinan reported shortly about the North-American meeting and promised to send the minutes a.s.a.p.. Michael informed us that electronic discovery was a "hot item" in North-America and that a lot of money was spent on this.
5. Johan brought in the idea to put this item on the agenda again during the next meeting at the World conference in Cancun, Mexico. He asked the regional representatives to prepare a presentation dealing with electronic discovery in their jurisdictions.
6. Since Patrizia had given a presentation at the meeting in Lisbon during the European conference about the differences between the EU and US, she offered that Johan could make use of this presentation for the Cancun conference, since she will not be able to be present at this World conference in Mexico.
7. It was decided that electronic discovery would indeed be the item to discuss during the IDRPG-meeting in Cancun.
8. Next item, which was brought on the agenda, was the newsletter. Johan informed the attendees that Karl Friedrich Dumoulin had volunteered to develop the IDR-newsletter. At the European conference, the majority of the attendees were of the opinion that there should only be an electronic version of the newsletter, since a hardcopy version would be very expensive. The attendees of the WebEx-meeting agreed on this, so for the near future the only goal is to realise an electronic version of the IDR newsletter.
9. Since Karl Friedrich needs input for this newsletter, Johan asked everybody to think of sending in contributions, so the first newsletter can be realized in the next few months.
10. Johan suggested that electronic discovery could be an item for the newsletter, but Michael was of the opinion that we should wait until after the World conference. Johan however was of the opinion that it could be useful to publish already what has been discussed at the several conferences, so we could go more into depth during the Cancun-conference.
11. Next item on the agenda was the possible IDR-brochure. At the European conference this item was discussed and it was decided that the hardcopy brochure would be very costly. Johan asked the participants about their opinion for a brochure. The majority was of the opinion that an electronic version would be sufficient enough. Since volunteers are still needed to realize this brochure, Johan asked again who ever wants to develop this brochure, please inform him about this soonest.



12. Johan informed the attendees that Patrizia was elected as regional vice-chairperson for Europe and Cornelia van Heerden as regional vice-chairperson for Asia/Africa.
13. Annina Bannwart informed Johan in the meantime, that since the IDRPG did not yet have a regional chairperson for Europe, she published Patrizia as a regional chairperson for Europe, instead of a regional vice-chairperson.
14. Johan asked both Michael and Luis to think of nominating regional vice-chairpersons for their regions at the next meeting.
15. Next item on the agenda was the development and planning of the IDRPG. Johan informed everybody that an annual business plan is needed and that as much members as possible need to participate in developing such a business plan. Johan asked the participants to send in their ideas, especially the ideas from the different regions. Both Michael and Luis promised to send their ideas as soon as possible.
16. Johan again informed the participants that it is necessary to divide the workload and that PG-members should be as active as possible so that the workload can be distributed amongst ourselves.
17. Johan asked who will be attending the Leadership meeting in Eisenberg. Up till now, only three IDR-members registered for that meeting there.
If there is a sufficient number of people present, Johan will organise a meeting in Eisenberg to discuss current affairs.
18. Since there was a lot of interference and the feedback of the participants was not received anymore by Johan, he decided to end the meeting and he thanked everybody for their attendance.
19. The next WebEx-meeting is scheduled for September 26th 2013 at 17:00 hours CET.
20. Johan will bring to the attention of the GGI-management the technical difficulties of this WebEx-meeting.
