## KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

## Jürg Kiener

## Biography



Jürg Kiener has more than 40 years' experience in the banking industry, with extensive know-how in the private banking, asset management and securities industries. Jürg has gained considerable global investment experience, having taken up postings in Zurich, Geneva, Johannesburg, London, Guernsey, Hong Kong and Singapore with two leading Swiss banks, Credit Suisse and Union Bancaire Privee. At these

banks, Jürg was involved in a significant amount of project work, integrating various businesses into the banks' networks. He was also responsible for setting up the Asian ex-Japan private banking units and responsible for Product Development and Asset & Wealth Management. Jürg has managed global and Asian funds and investment mandates, both on an absolute and relative basis. Through project work in Credit Suisse he also gained a good knowledge of settlement and securities ownership, derivatives and structured products, the precious metals universe and alternative asset management.

Jürg was a founding member of Swiss Asia Capital (SAC) at the end of 1999, specialising in the precious metals and resources market with a focus on Asia-Pacific. SAC is advising clients on direct ownership and registration of investment assets and is active as a fund and portfolio manager for institutional and high net worth clients. Jürg is frequently featured on television for CNBC Asia, BBC and Bloomberg. He is also a regular speaker at global investment conferences.

## Speech Summary

Since 2008 global debt has grown by 40%, a far greater pace than global GDP. There has been no deleveraging on a global basis. The just-published report on the global economy by the International Centre for Monetary and Banking Studies warns of a "poisonous combination of high and rising debt and slowing nominal GDP". The global debt-to-GDP ratio was 215% in 2013 vs 200% in 2009 and increased, as public sector debt has risen to 156%.

Unfortunately only the achievement of sustained robust growth will restore the possibility of servicing debt at normalised interest rates. We believe that radical monetary policies are here to stay, even if the baton of debasement is passed from one central bank to another. A critical state will be reached when markets and policy makers realise that additional credit creation does not stimulate growth. In the absence of robust global growth, currency debasement policies will accelerate in order to protect economies. Countries with structural deficits and open capital accounts will find it difficult to sustain growth. The above scenario is asking for drastic reforms. We expect Asian policies will generally aim to prevent unemployment from rising and to sustain wage growth when exports slow, resulting in currency debasement, whilst corporates will shift from growth strategies to a focus on capital returns. Credit and default risks are rising substantially.

## Dr Supachai Panitchpakdi

## Biography

Supachai Panitchpakdi's career has spanned wide-ranging areas. Starting off as an officer of the Bank of Thailand, he became Deputy Finance Minister, Commerce Minister, and twice Deputy Prime Minister. In between he assumed for some years the presidency role of a commercial bank, and chairman of several private corporations including an international insurance company. His international career is noteworthy for the fact that he is the first representative of the developing countries to be appointed Director General of the World Trade Organisation (2002-2005) and followed that up with two terms as Secretary General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (2005-2013). At present he is a board member of the Institute for Cultural Diplomacy in Berlin, a founding member of the Asia-New Zealand Foundation, and recently appointed by the UN Secretary General to serve as the High Level Panel of Experts on Budget Recosting.

### International Taxation (ITPG)

Ashish Bairagra

This meeting will begin with updates from ITPG members around the world, followed by updates from ITPG Asia-Pacific and information about ITPG meetings to be held in 2015. R.A. Jayaweera, from the GGI member firm P.E. Mathew & Co. Chartered Accountants in Sri Lanka, will present on how international transactions are taxed in his country. Lisa Greig, from GGI member firm Cummings Flavel McCormack, will then discuss the idiosyncrasies of Australian tax and the current focus of the Australian Tax Office. Finally, Vijesh Zinzuwadia from Zinzuwadia & Co. CA in India will highlight the latest international tax controversy that has hit Vodafone in India.

After the coffee break, William Wong and Gilbert Mak, from GGI member firm Horizon Group in Beijing, will provide an update on VAT in China, following which Ashish Bairagra will lead a debate on some international tax case studies. The meeting will end with a speed networking session, giving ITPG members a chance to get to know each other better and to perhaps discover how synergies may be developed amongst fellow ITPG members.

### Auditing, Reporting & Compliance

Ricky Wong

Ricky Wong, from GGI member firm Wong Brothers & Co. Certified Public Accountants in Hong Kong, will discuss quality control requirements during this Practice Group meeting. Additionally, he will look into the code of ethics as well as issues relating to the “going concern” principle.

ISQC 1 deals with a firm’s responsibilities for its system of quality control for audits and reviews of financial statements. CPAs have to ensure compliance with the Standards.

Independence and professional ethics form an integral part of ISQC 1, and CPAs are required to understand.

“Going concern” is a fundamental principle in preparation of financial statements, and CPAs need to assess the appropriateness of such assumption when performing audit.

## **Global Political Economy and International Relations – Understanding the International Economic Order**

Claudio G. Cocca

### **Is the world facing a new political order?**

We wanted to believe that Russia could become part of a united Europe. However, Russia feels the enlargement of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation (NATO) and the planned European Union (EU) Association Agreement with Ukraine is an infringement of its sphere of influence, which triggered the Ukraine conflict. Are we on the verge of a new Cold War?

Japan is battling through a permanent state of crisis with an historic glut of money. However, none of this has been able to make a difference and the Japanese economy is once again sliding into recession. Is this a taste of what is to come for Europe?

While banks in Europe are forced to provide ever more capital to hedge their risks, China's banks are ballooning. Economists fear a credit crisis. Has a lending bubble emerged in China and will it soon burst, causing the global economy to be thrown into a state of crisis?

A further topic of the meeting is the gloomy economic situation in the eurozone, especially in France and Italy. The recent intervention by the European Central Bank (ECB) shows that the situation is much more serious than is perceived by the public. Great challenges still lie ahead for the eurozone.

During 2014, we developed the case study, "**A lucky life**", and discussed it at all our practice group meetings in Milan, Edinburgh and Cape Town. We will continue to do this here in Bangkok, and request all attending members continue to study this and provide constructive feedback. ## M&A

William Wong

The Wall Street Journal (WSJ) noted earlier in 2014 that deal activity hit a record high in APAC during the first half of this year. In particular, M&A activity remains strong in China.

Tax is one of the key considerations in an M&A deal. William Wong, hailing from GGI member firm Horizon Group in Beijing, will provide a quick update on Chinese tax rules and explain how they could affect the acquirers' decisions from the cash repatriation, divestment and reorganisation perspectives. He will also share his views on a tax-effective holding structure for Chinese outbound investments.

Apart from tax, closing account mechanisms are also important in M&A transactions. Robert Thompson, from GGI member firm Ward Hadaway in the UK, will share his experience in this regard, which would be very useful for providing M&A services in APAC.
