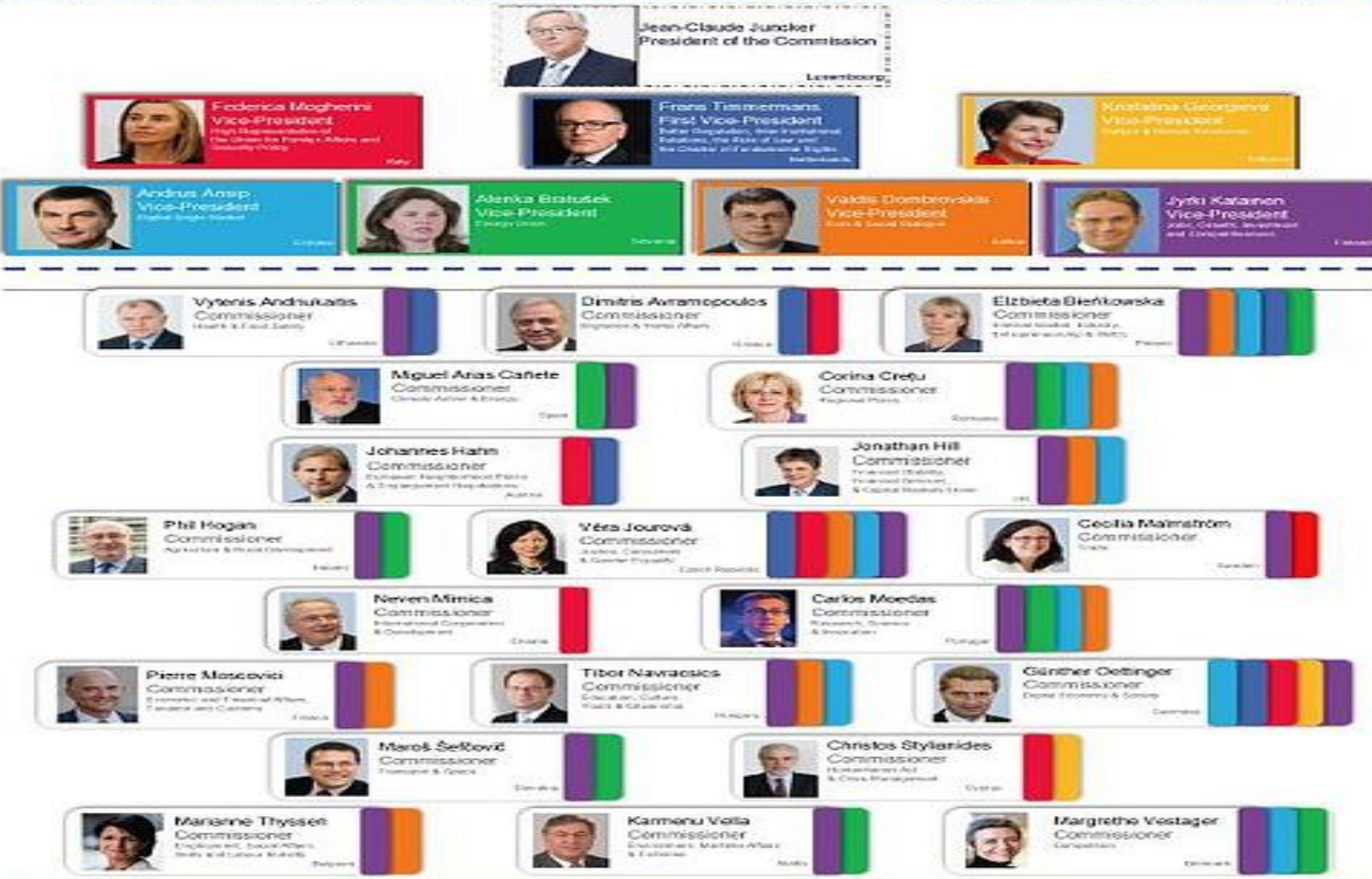

The Juncker Commission: Who's Working with Whom?

In one of the main innovations of the 2014-2019 European Commission, seven Vice-Presidents (VPs) will steer and coordinate the work of 20 Commissioners. The new structure is relatively complex at first glance and is not designed to be strictly hierarchical or cluster-based. It is intended to breakdown political silos, and there is deliberate overlap in terms of the policy areas and project teams the VPs are responsible for. Based on the mission letters sent to each of the 20 Commissioners, **acumen public affairs** maps out which Commissioners will be working with which VPs in the Juncker Commission. Each VP is colour coded: the Commissioners are coded with the colour of the VPs they will work with. (A more detailed explanation of the categorisation is provided in the footer below)



In their mission letters, each of the 20 Commissioners was informed by President Juncker that he/she will "contribute to projects steered and coordinated by one or more VP, listed above by the coloured bar. These project teams are subject to change over time. Each Commissioner is also told that "for other initiatives requiring a decision from the Commission, you will, as a rule, liaise closely with" one specific VP, represented above by the first coloured bar. This does not necessarily mean that they will work most with this VP - e.g. Commissioner Moscovici looks set to work most closely with VP Dombrovskis - but it does indicate who their "go-to" VP is when project leads are not clear. Finally, in addition to coordinating with individual Commissioners in stipulated policy areas (about 60000 more VPs' responsibilities and Georgieva will oversee the work of all Commissioners through their horizontal roles.

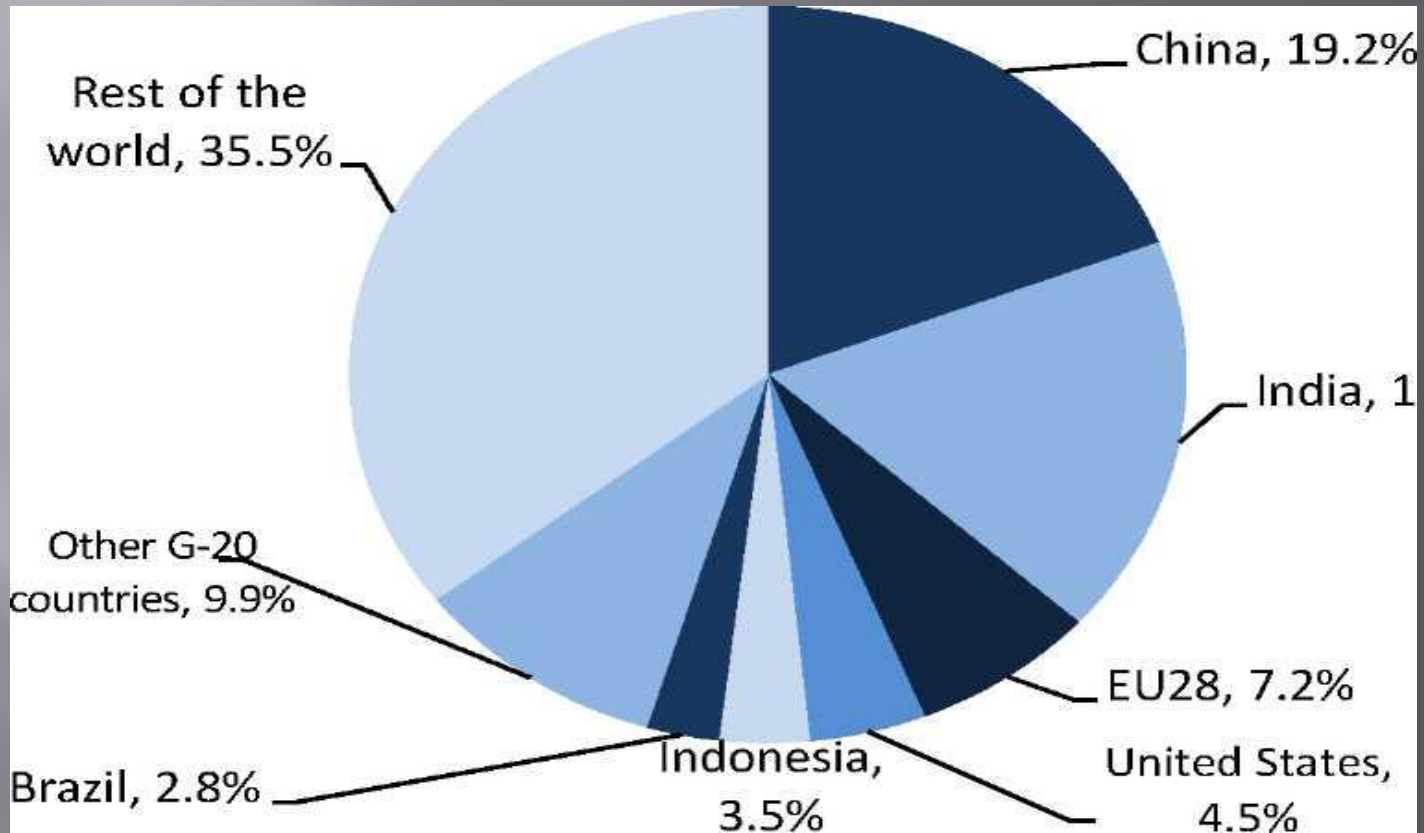

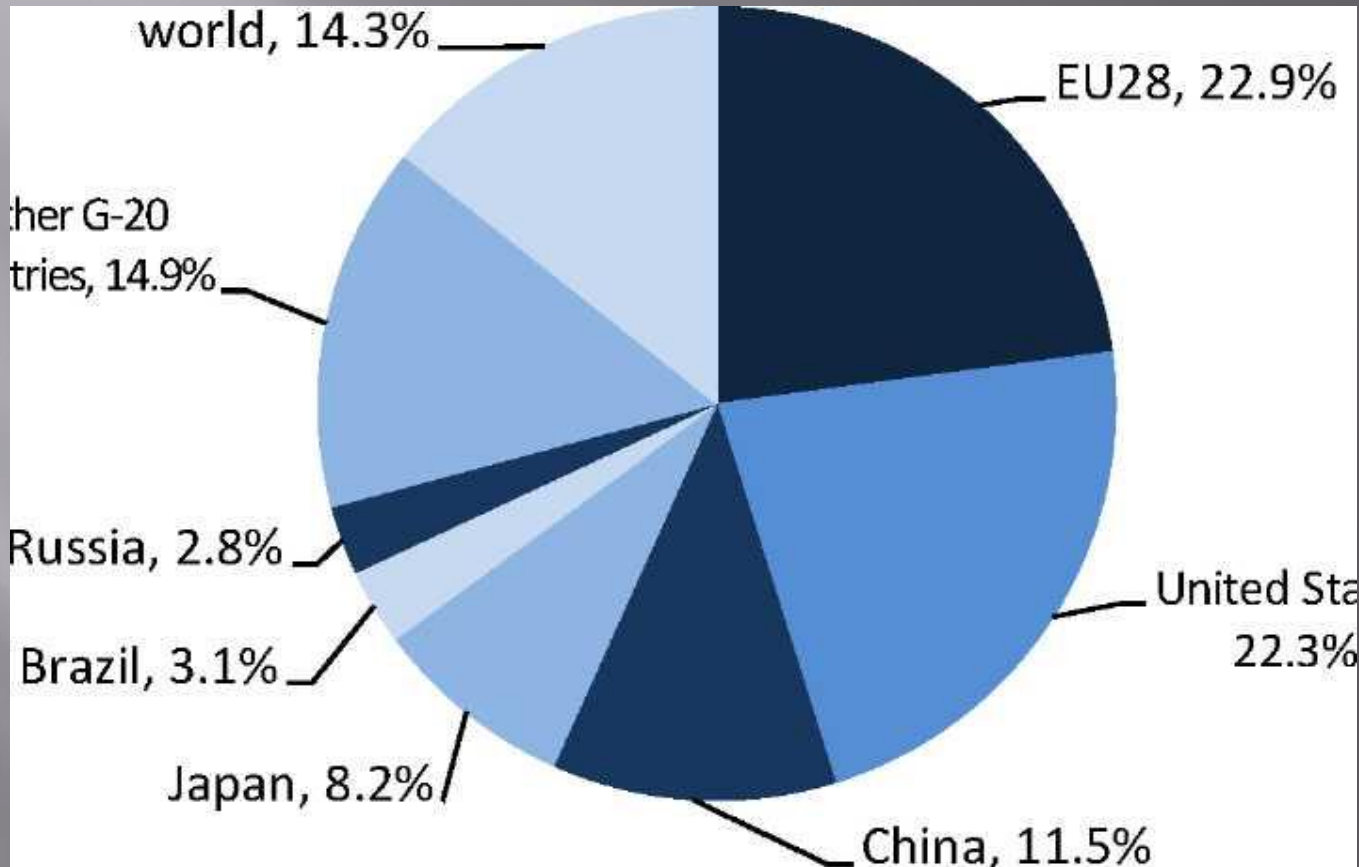

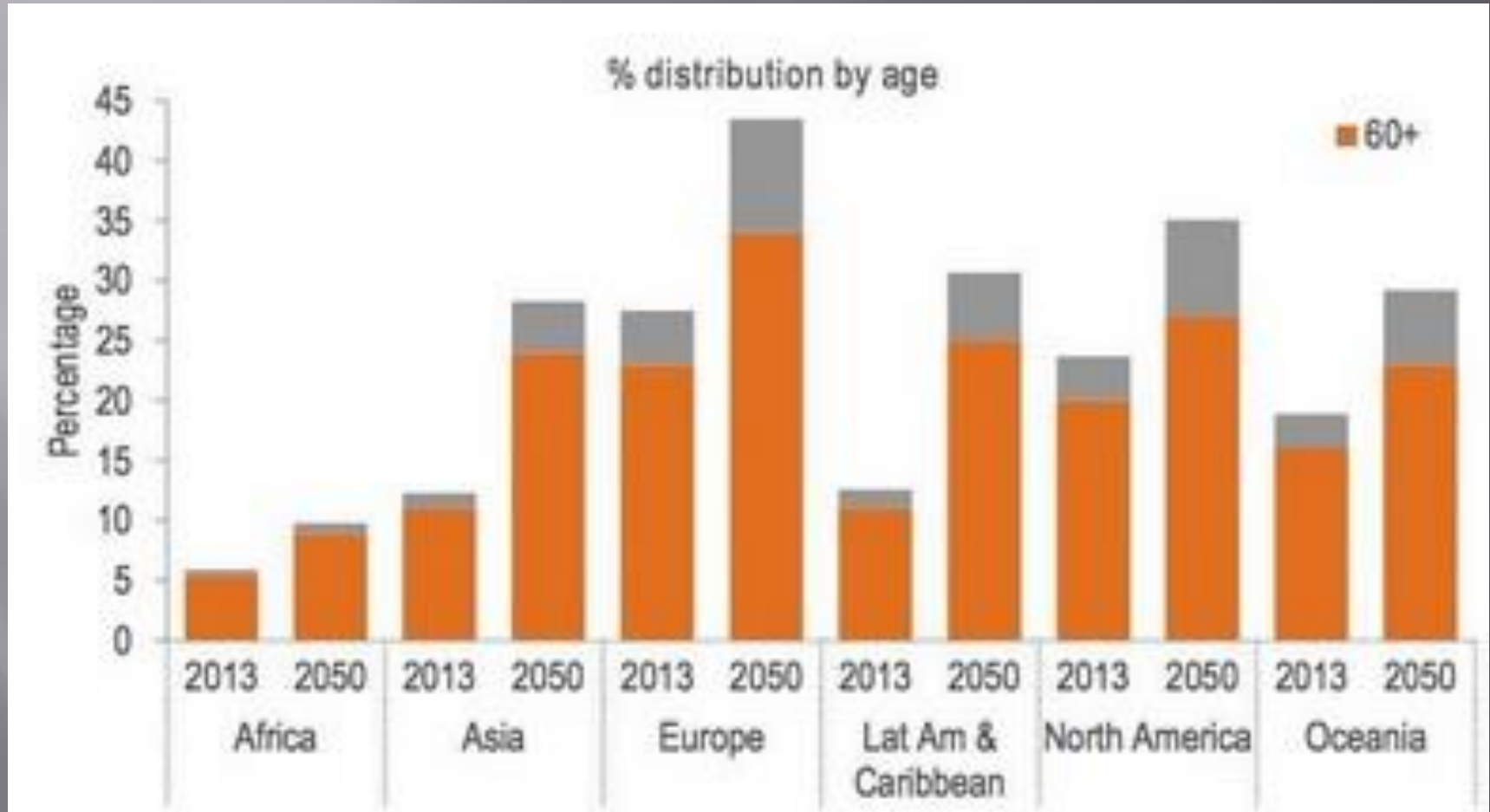
Share of world population, 2012
