a) Saint Honorat / Lérins Island

The evocation of SaintHonoratus necessarily involved the monastic community that occupies the island which bears his name. The Abbey of Lérins is home to Cistercian monks, heirs to the Benedictine order who, since the 5th century, exploited the site's natural resources by cultivating vineyards. Facing the open sea, St. Honorat is now a famous tourist destination ideal for meditation, but also for tasting excellent vintages.

b) Antibes City and Picasso Museum

Once an ancient Greek city, today Antibes is a lovely resort, with a modern Marina for deluxe yachts and a marvellous old town. You will become familiar with this old fortified city and the famous characters who once lived there or passed through: G. de Maupassant, V. Hugo, J.Verne etc. Thereafter you will visit the fabulous Picasso Museum in the XIII-XIV century GrimaldiCastle which houses one of the world's finest collections of the artist.



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c) Vallauris and Biot Verrerie

Ideally located on the French Riviera between Cannes and Antibes, Vallauris displays the charms of a village with a ceramic tradition. You will drive to La Verrerie de Biot where the glass tradition in Provence dates back thousands of years. However, in Biot everything began in 1956, the year in which La Verrerie de Biot created bubble glass, mastering the bubble and imprisoning it between two layers of glass to transform a defect (a bubble) into a feature of quality. The essence of Biot glassware is in the bubbles; each glass is unique.
