Discover Toledo

Fifty miles from Madrid, this ancient capital of Spain rises up over the surrounding plain like an El Greco masterpiece. Toledo is over eighteen centuries old and stands on top of a granite hill, surrounded on three sides by the gorge of the fast-flowing Tagus River. The guided tour includes lunch at Hostal del Cardenal, an original Toledan palace, which has been so successfully restored and converted into a hotel and restaurant that it has become the most famous in the Imperial City of Toledo.

Opera, music, theatre, paintings, sculptures... Madrid does not merely showcase culture, it symbolizes it. Music and opera lovers will have the opportunity to indulge their fancy in an incomparable setting. Originally built in 1850 and recently renovated, Madrid's Teatro Real now hosts opera, concerts and ballet, with an open door policy. The Plaza Mayor is a grand arcaded square in the center of Madrid and is very popular with tourists and locals alike. Guests will have the chance to sample the famous Spanish “tapas” in the square.

- a) Panoramic tour by bus & Thyssen Museum walking tour

After a wonderful panoramic tour in the city of Madrid we stop at the Thyssen Museum. It houses a magnificent collection of over 800 works and was acquired from Baron von Thyssen by the Spanish government. As well as a rich collection of Old Masters, the museum has a wonderful modern section, which includes French Impressionists Manet, Monet and Degas.

- b) Panoramic tour by bus & visit to the Royal Palace

This tour provides participants with an exciting insight into the historical city of Madrid. The Royal Palace, home of the Spanish Crown, is the single most important palace in Spain, and arguably the best maintained in Europe. The Royal Palace is an enormous, 18th century building, which consists of 2,800 rooms. Housing tapestries, a royal clock collection and five Stradivarius violins, as well as a Chandelier collection, the palace is a “must see” while in Madrid. Though the Spanish Royal Family no longer lives in these quarters, the palace still plays host on state visits.

- c) Panoramic tour by bus & visit to “Santiago Bernabeu” of Real Madrid

We are sure that most of you are interested in the world famous football Stadium, the Santiago Bernabeu Stadium. It is home to Spain's favorite sport – soccer! The stadium hosts the best soccer teams in the world (according to the FIFA ranking system) and seats over ninety thousand people. It truly represents Spain's love of soccer. The interior of the stadium holds thousands of sporting mementoes as well as the renowned trophy collection, where you can find almost every known soccer championship trophy.
